Weekend Policy

Students' weekend pick-up policy(on Thursday)

1. If a parent wants to pick up their children before the weekend, they must email by Wednesday at 5 PM.
2. Before leaving campus, students must complete the exit / weekend leave form. No student will be permitted to pass through the gate if this form is not deposited to the security post or guard.
3. Children's parents or guardians will be waiting for them in the dining hall. Parents or guardians are not permitted to enter their children's dorms.
5. After the class, students will meet their parents in the dining hall, and from there they will take their departure.
6. After 6 PM, no student will be permitted to leave for the weekend. (If there is any trouble then that will be taken into consideration).
7. No bags and luggage should be brought to the room.
8. Security personnel will inspect students' personal belongings for everyone's safety.

Students' drop-off policy following the weekend(on Friday/Saturday)

1. Students need to arrive on campus by 5:00 p.m. on the weekends.
2. Parents / guardians can help their children up to the dining hall.
3. Parents are not permitted to enter their children's dorms.
4. No wet food is allowed to be brought. If it is found, it will be seized by the school authority.
5. All kinds of bags and luggage will be checked. Security personnel will inspect students' personal belongings for everyone's safety.
6. Parent-child time is permitted until 5:00 p.m. The dining hall, tennis court, basketball court, and library are all open to them. The swimming pool is off limits to all visitors.
7. Parents / guardians are requested to vacate the campus area by 5 PM.

Weekend Visiting policy for parents and guardian(on Friday/ Saturday)

1. Parents must inform by email beforehand.
2. The dining hall is the only place where they can see their children.
3. They can bring home-made food and feed their children in the dining hall, but no food will be allowed to be carried to their room.
4. They have until 5:00 PM to spend time with their children.
5. Parents / guardians can take their children out of the campus with prior permission of the headmaster.
